ITINERARY

DAY 1 SAT MAR 12 FLIGHT TO MEXICO-SHRINE OF OUR LADY

We fly from Toronto to Mexico City aboard Air Canada. Sit back, relax and enjoy your flight. Group seating for our flight will be pre-assigned by the airline. Upon arrival, welcome by our local English speaking guide and drive to our centrally located hotel. We check-in and enjoy free time for lunch on our own. We visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe and begin the pilgrimage in a very solemn way. We will have time to take in the brilliantly colored, modern Basilica dedicated in 1976. Join in prayers with those of other pilgrims as you kneel before the altar displaying the astounding "Tilma", the sackcloth bearing the image of the Holy Virgin. We return to our hotel and get ready for our first Mexican dinner.

Overnight Mexico City

Day 2 Sun Mar 13 Shrine of Our Lady-Teotihuacan

Travel via the Plaza of the Three Cultures we arrive at the Shrine of Our Lady to celebrate morning prayers. Continue to the Archaeological zone of San Juan Teotihuacan, a UNESCO World Heritage site, visiting the Pyramids of the Sun and the Moon, Temple of Quetzalcoatl, and local arts and crafts markets. Along the way, you will be enchanted by the artful blending of pre-Hispanic and Hispanic cultures. We return to our hotel and enjoy some time to relax before dinner

Overnight Mexico City Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

DAY 3 MON MAR 14 MEXICO CITY

Pray at the Holy Family Church and visit the tomb of Fr. Miguel Agustin Pro, S.J. the Jesuit martyr. Drive to Historical Mexico City and visit the Zocalo. See the National Palace, visit the Metropolitan Cathedral and see the Tomb of Bishop Zumarraga. Continue on to the Plaza of Santo Domingo, the first church built by the Dominicans in 1576. Housed within the Plaza is the first rosary shrine in Mexico, Our Lady of the Rosary; and a second shrine, Our Lady of Covadonga (headquarters of the Confraternity of the Most Holy Rosary, founded in 1538).

Overnight Mexico City Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

Day 4 Tue Mar 15 Excursion to Tlaxcala and Puebla

We leave Mexico City for a spectacular ride with a view of the two most famous peaks, one covered with eternal snow, and next to it is the one with volcano. Our first stop is Tlaxcala, the Shrine of San Miguel Del Milagro. Upon arrival, we will pray at the site where St. Michael the Archangel appeared to Diego Lazaro in 1631. It was there

that St. Michael directed him to the Grotto and to a well of miraculous curative waters (bring an empty small bottle to collect some miraculous water). Later we proceed to Puebla to see St. Dominic's Church and the magnificent Chapel of Our Lady of the Rosary, with its most famous scalloped gold leaf walls and ceilings. Then visit the Church of St. Francis of Assisi to see the incorrupt body of St. Sebastian de Aparicio. This evening we will return to our hotel very late (approximately 9PM).

Day 5 Wed Mar 16 Shrine of Our Lady

This morning we will return to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe for prayers and to bid farewell to Mary the Mother of God. You will have some free time for private devotion and reflection. We return to our hotel for our last afternoon in Mexico City to relax, explore on our own and shop for that special souvenir to bring home.
