Our Lady of Lourdes is a Roman Catholic title of the Mary, mother of Jesus, venerated in honour of the Marian apparitions that occurred in Lourdes, France.

The first apparition of 11 February 1858, of which Bernadette Soubirous told her mother that a "Lady" spoke to her in the cave of Massabielle

while she was gathering firewood with her sister and a friend. Similar apparitions of the "Lady" were reported on 18 occasions that year, until the climax revelation of Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception took place.

On 18 January 1862, the local Bishop of Tarbes Bertrand-Sévère Laurence endorsed the veneration of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Lourdes.

Jeremiah (c. 650 - c. 570 BC), also called the "weeping prophet", was one of the major prophets of the Hebrew Bible. There are four maior prophets, Isaiah. Ezekiel Daniel, and Jeremiah. The term "major" not reflect their does importance but rather is based on the length of their writings.

The prophet Jeremiah, called to be a prophet at a young age, was the voice of God denouncing the infidelity of the Israelites, warning them of an imminent destruction, unless they changed their

ways. The warnings fell on deaf ears and the prophet was mistreated by his own people. The Babylonians conquered Judah and Jerusalem, and many people were taken into exile which lasted 70 years.
