Imagine yourself in the Galilee at the same site where Jesus taught and performed his miracles, renewing your baptismal promises in the Jordan River, walking through the streets of Jerusalem and reflecting on the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. It is an experience that will enrich your faith and change your life. Come and see for yourself, you'll never be the same.

ITINERARY

DAY 1 JANUARY 15

FLIGHT TORONTO-TEL AVIV

Fly from Toronto to Tel Aviv. Prepare yourself for an experience that will change your life. In only few hours you will be walking in the same path that Jesus walked! Group seating for our flight will be pre-assigned by the airline.

Day 2 January 16

TEL AVIV-NAZARETH

Welcome to Israel! Upon arrival and clearing customs and immigration, we meet our guide and drive to Nazareth. It is here that the Word became Flesh (Luke 1:30-31) and it all began. We get settled in our rooms and enjoy free time to rest. We visit the Church of the Annunciation and pray by the house of Mary. **Dinner**

Day 3 January 17 Wedding in Cana-Transfiguration of the Lord

Couples who are present will have the opportunity today to renew their wedding vows in Cana, where the Shrine reminds us of the first miracle of Jesus turning water into wine (John 2:1-11). Continue to Mt. Tabor to pray at the Church of the Transfiguration, traditional site of the Transfiguration of Christ (Luke 9:28-36). Arrive at our hotel near the Sea of Galilee and get settled for the next 2 nights.

DAY 4 JANUARY 18

THE MINISTRY OF JESUS

We take a relaxing boat ride across the Sea of Galilee recalling the miracle of walking on water (Matthew 14:22-33) and calling on Peter and Andrew to become 'fishers of men' (Matthew 4:19). In Capernaum, Jesus' town (Mathew 9:1) and the center of his ministry (Matthew 4:13, 23), see the remains of the ancient Synagogue where our Lord preached and the new church built atop St. Peter's house. It is here where Jesus spent most of his public life. In Tabgha, traditional location of the feeding of the 5,000, see the splendid mosaic of the miracle of the loaves and fishes (Mathew 14:13-21; Mark 6:32-44; Luke 9:12-17; John 6:1-15), pray at the Chapel of the Primacy where Jesus reinstates Peter (John 21:15-19) and reflect at the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus preached the Sermon of the Mount (Mathew 5:3-11; Luke 6:20-26). We visit Magdala and explore the home town of Mary Magdalene.

Day 5 January 19 Jordan River-Jesus' Temptation-Jerusalem

We visit the Jordan River and whoever wants may renew their baptismal promises. Next we follow the route to the Mount of Temptation, traditional site where Jesus spent forty days and forty nights and was tempted by Satan (Matthew 4:1-11; Mark 1:12; Luke 4:1). In Jericho, recall the story about the poor blind man (Luke 18:35-43) and Zacchaeus, the tax collector (Luke 19:1-10). We ascend the Judean Hills towards Jerusalem and see the breathtaking beauty of the *Golden City*, "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord" (Psalm 118:26)! From atop Mt. of Olives we follow Palm Sunday road to the Chapel of Dominus Flevit, traditional site where Jesus wept over Jerusalem (Luke 19:41-44). We arrive at our hotel, our home for the next 4 nights.

DAY 6 JANUARY 20 CAIAPHAS HOUSE-DORMITION OF MARY-PASSION OF CHRIST

Start the morning at the Church of St Peter in Gallicantu and recall Peter's denial of Christ (Matthew 26:69-75). Next we visit Dormition Abbey, where Mary "fell into eternal sleep", and the Upper Room, where Jesus shared the last meal with his Apostles the night before he died (Matthew 26:17–30, Mark 14:12–26, Luke 22:7–39 and John 13:1–17:26). See the outdoor model of Jerusalem at the time of Jesus. We enter the Old City and visit the Church of St. Ann, traditional birthplace of the Virgin Mary. See the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus performed the miracle of healing (John 5:2-9). We prayerfully follow the last footsteps of Jesus as we walk the Way of the Cross, something unforgettable in our pilgrimage, ending at the site of the Crucifixion of Christ (Calvary), and the site of the Sepulcher.

Day 7 January 21

BETHLEHEM AND THE SHEPHERDS FIELDS

This morning we celebrate the Birth of our Lord in Bethlehem. At the Church of the Nativity, see the Manger and the Grotto of St. Jerome, and at the Shepherd's field we remember the humble shepherds listening to the angels that sang: "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace among those whom he favors! (Luke 2:14). Back in Jerusalem there will be some free time to browse around the Old City colourful Market.

DAY 8 JANUARY 22 GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE-MAGNIFICAT-DEAD SEA

Our last day in the Holy Land. We visit the Western Wall and pray at the Garden of Gethsemane (Mark 14:36), next at the Church of the Visitation, where the Blessed Virgin Mary visited her cousin Elizabeth and proclaimed the Magnificat (Luke 1:46-55). We spend the afternoon in the Judean wilderness to relax and float in the salt water of the Dead Sea. This is going to be fun!

Breakfast, Dinner

DAY 9 JANUARY 23

FLIGHT TEL AVIV-TORONTO

Today we fly home. We celebrate Jesus' resurrection, *He is not here, He has Risen* (Matthew 28:6), and feel deeply moved for the spiritual experience that we have just lived, knowing that we have walked in the footsteps of Jesus, the Virgin Mary and the Apostols bringing new meaning to our Scripture reading and celebration of Mass. We will cherish the memories that will last a lifetime. We land at Toronto International Airport. **END OF OUR PILGRIMAGE.** *Breakfast, Meals on board*
