#### DAY 1 SUNDAY MAY 21

FLIGHT(S) TO VENICE

We fly from Toronto to Venice. Sit back, relax and enjoy your flight. Group seating for our flight will be pre-assigned by the airline. Overnight on board

#### DAY 2 MONDAY MAY 22

**VENICE-PADUA** 

Ciao Italy! Upon arrival and clearing customs and immigration, we meet our tour manager and board our bus to drive us to Padua. We Check-in at our hotel and enjoy time to rest. Our pilgrimage officially begins with prayers at the Basilica of Saint Anthony and devotion by the tomb of the Saint followed a Welcome Dinner with all the members of our group. Dinner Overnight: Padua

#### DAY 3 TUESDAY MAY 23

### **EXCURSION TO VENICE**

Today we take the vaporetto through the Grand Canal to Venice. We'll see Piazza San Marco, the Doge Palace, famous bridges of Venice, pray at St. Mark's Basilica and enjoy a Gondola ride. For lunch we suggest you do what Venetians do, head out to a bacaro or wine bar, for some cicchetti or small bites of traditional Venetian fare and a glass of wine (a similar concept to Spanish tapas). Return to Padua. Dinner including pizza and Bigoli pasta (typical from this region). Overnight: Padua Breakfast, Dinner

#### DAY 4 WEDNESDAY MAY 24

# **BOLOGNA-FLORENCE**

You may want to join other pilgrims for early prayers at the Basilica before breakfast. We leave Padua for Bologna well known all over the world for their pasta and cured meats. We'll enjoy a food extravaganza tasting Parmigiano Reggiano, local charcuterie and sip aged balsamic vinegar. We'll take time to stroll through the Piazza Maggiore and see the city's two famous towers, the Torre degli Asinelli and Torre della Garisenda. Lunch will be on our own. Our guide has great recommendations for restaurants highlighting Emilia-Romagna cuisine if you are interested. Continue to Florence, the "Cradle of the Renaissance". Tonight you will learn why there's no such thing as "Italian" food. We'll start with an aperitivo, then a typical starter of classic Tuscan soup, savour artisanal cheese and cured local meats paired with the perfect local vino and end your meal as Florentines do with a gelato (invented here in Florence).

## DAY 5 THURSDAY, MAY 25

# Breakfast. Dinner

FLORENCE This morning pray at the Cathedral Santa Maria del Fiore. Visit the Accademia Gallery to admire Michelangelo's David and enjoy a walking tour to see the Baptistry, Piazza della Repubblica, the sculpture-studded Piazza della Signoria and the Ponte Vecchio. You'll have the afternoon free to stroll and explore. Dinner tonight will include the famous "Bistecca alla Fiorentina" (steak Florentine style), one of the glories of Tuscan Cuisine. Breakfast, Dinner **Overnight:** Florence

#### DAY 6 FRIDAY, MAY 26

**TUSCAN COUNTRYSIDE-SAN GIMIGNANO-SIENA** We depart Florence and drive through the heart of Tuscany and the Chianti region to San Gimignano, one of the most charming and picturesque hill towns in Tuscany. There will be free time to wander through the narrow streets, climb the "Torre Grossa" and take pictures of the gorgeous landscape. We visit a local winery and experience a farm-to-table lunch in one of the most beautiful settings in San Gimignano. Continue on a short drive to Siena, birthplace of St. Catherine. We arrive at our hotel, get settled and enjoy the rest of the afternoon and evening at leisure. Dinner is on your own.

#### DAY 7 SATURDAY MAY 27

This morning we visit the Duomo of Siena, one of Italy's greatest cathedrals. Wander through medieval cobblestone alleyways, see splendid Renaissance palaces, Piazza del Campo and pray at the Church of St. Dominic which houses the reliquary containing the incorrupt head and thumb of St. Catherine. The afternoon is at leisure. Tonight we learn how to cook the Italian way and get to enjoy our own creation. This is going to be fun! Overnight: Siena Breakfast, Dinner

#### DAY 8 SUNDAY MAY 28

SIENA-ASSISI

Today we drive to Assisi, the town of St. Francis and St. Clare. Assisi is a spiritual treasure and one of the most peaceful spots in Italy. We visit the Basilica of St. Francis, which contains many of the possessions of St. Francis and a series of frescoes depicting his life. You will have a chance to see where St. Francis knelt before the crucifix and heard Jesus ask him to rebuild His church. We will also visit the Basilica of St. Clare and pray before the Holy Crucifix from which God spoke to Francis. We check in at our hotel and enjoy some time to rest and explore on our own before a delicious meal with regional Umbrian specialties and wines. Overnight: Assisi Breakfast, Dinner

#### DAY 9 MONDAY MAY 29

We depart towards Rome for the last leg of our pilgrimage. We arrive at our hotel and check-in for 3 nights. In the afternoon begin our sightseeing of Rome with a stop at the Colosseum (outside view) for a picture opportunity. Continue with a leisurely walk through the historic center of Rome to see the Trevi Fountain, the Spanish Steps and Piazza Navona including dinner with traditional Roman dishes at one of its trendy restaurants for people watching

and enjoy the ambiance of the Piazza.

Today we learn the stories and legends of early Christianity visiting three of the major basilicas: St. John Lateran, the oldest Basilica in Rome and the official seat of the Pope. Across from it we visit the Holy Stairs, regarded as the stairs climbed by Jesus on his way to face Pontius Pilate. Continue to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, believed to be the burial ground of St. Paul and finally the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the oldest shrines dedicated to the Blessed Virgin. The afternoon is at leisure. We'll meet again for supper and enjoy a classic of the Italian cuisine: Lasagna alla Bolognese. Overnight: Rome Breakfast, Dinner

#### DAY 11 WEDNESDAY MAY 31

#### PAPAL AUDIENCE & VATICAN CITY Today is a very emotional day. We arrive at St. Peter's Square to participate in the Papal Audience and to be blessed by the Holy Father (providing His Holiness is in residence). We will also have some free time to shop for religious souvenirs, stroll and explore on our own. In the afternoon we embark on a visit to the Vatican Museum and the incomparable Sistine Chapel. We end our visit at St. Peter's Basilica. Built on the site where St. Peter was martyred, is the largest church in Christendom. A visit to St. Peter's Basilica is awe-inspiring, breathtaking, speechless. Tonight we toast to a fabulous trip and new friends, and enjoy a Farewell Dinner at one of the best restaurants in the heart of Trastevere. **Overnight: Rome**
