

About St. Anne: St. Anne, Hebrew for Hannah, meaning "grace", eventually became the patron saint of married women and childless couples.

The angel Gabriel appeared to her and to her husband, St. Joachim, separately and declared that they would in fact bear

a child who must be dedicated to God.

Anne and her husband miraculously conceived the Virgin as they kissed before the Golden Gate of Jerusalem, after the apparition of the angel.

As the grandparents of Jesus, Anne and her husband Joachim are also considered the patron saints of grandparents.

- If grandparents live close by invite them over for dinner.
- Call grandparents on the phone to say hello and to catch up.
- Send a card in the mail thanking the grandparents in your life for their love and support
