Dear Confirmation Candidates and Families,

As we enter the 2022-2023 School year, those in grade 7, or older, are invited to consider preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation. This sacrament completes the Initiation process into the Church that began at baptism. Grade 7 is the minimum age that a Catholic can make this Sacrament; however, an individual is welcome to receive it—if he or she has not already done so—at an older age. Likewise, anyone in grade 7 who does not feel ready, is not compelled to make it at this point in time.
