BUNDLE UP FOR THE SOCIETY OF SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL




The Society will be collecting donations at our parish on the weekend of October 15-16, 2022.

Starting this first Friday, we will be using the holy oil of Saint Joseph for our healing Masses.



Saint Joseph Oil is not a treatment nor a preparation with curative powers, It must be viewed as a gesture of faith.

St. Brother Andre was inspired by a devotion that was already being practiced in France. He took a bit of oil from

a lamp that was burning in front of a statue of Saint Joseph. He offered it to sick people telling them to rub it on their aching body and to pray to Saint Joseph for relief.

This tradition continues today at Saint Joseph's Oratory of Mount Royal. A basin containing ordinary vegetable oil is fixed in front of a statue of Saint Joseph, and a wick, floating on the surface, burns night and day as a perpetual votive lamp. The oil is then put in bottles and made available to pilgrims.
