## **ITINERARY**

#### FLIGHT TORONTO-TEL AVIV **DAY 1 SUNDAY FEBRUARY 18**

We fly to Tel Aviv aboard Air Canada. Prepare yourself for an experience that will change your life. In only few hours you will be walking in the same path that Jesus walked! Group seating for our flight will be assigned by the airline.

#### **DAY 2 MONDAY FEBRUARY 19** TEL AVIV-NAZARETH

Welcome to Israel! Upon arrival and clearing immigration formalities, we meet our local guide and drive to Nazareth. We check-in at our hotel and get settled in our rooms. Celebrate the beginning of our Pilgrimage right here where it all began. At the Church of the Annunciation pray by the House of Mary, where the Word became Flesh (Luke 1:30-31) and visit the Carpentry of Jesus. Enjoy dinner and retire for the evening.

#### **DAY 3 TUESDAY FEBRUARY 20** ALL AROUND THE GALILEE

A rewarding day...Start the day in Cana, where the Shrine reminds us of the first miracle of Jesus turning water into wine (John 2:1-11), couples who are present could renew their wedding vows at this same spot. Next to Mt. Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration of Christ (Luke 9:28-36). Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

#### **DAY 4 WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 21** THE MINISTRY OF JESUS

We take a relaxing boat ride across the Sea of Galilee recalling the miracle of walking on water (Matthew 14:22-33) and calling on Peter and Andrew to become 'fishers of men' (Matthew 4:19). In Capernaum, Jesus' town (Mathew 9:1) and the center of his ministry (Matthew 4:13, 23), see the remains of the ancient Synagogue where our Lord preached, and the new church built atop St. Peter's house. It is here where Jesus spent most of his public life. In Tabgha, traditional location of the feeding of the 5,000, see the splendid mosaic of the miracle of the loaves and fishes (Mathew 14:13-21; Mark 6:32-44; Luke 9:12-17; John 6:1-15), pray at the Chapel of the Primacy where Jesus reinstates Peter (John 21:15-19) and reflect at the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus preached the Sermon of the Mount (Mathew 5:3-11; Luke 6:20-26). We visit Magdala and explore the hometown of Mary Magdalene.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

## DAY 5 THURSDAY FEBRUARY 22 JESUS' BAPTISM & TEMPTATION-JERUSALEM

We visit the Jordan River and whoever wants may renew their baptismal promises. Next, we follow the route to the Mount of Temptation, traditional site where Jesus spent forty days and forty nights and was tempted by Satan (Matthew 4:1-11; Mark 1:12; Luke 4:1). In Jericho, recall the story about the poor blind man (Luke 18:35-43) and Zacchaeus, the tax collector (Luke 19:1-10). We ascend the Judean Hills towards Jerusalem and see the breathtaking beauty of the Golden City, "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord" (Psalm 118:26)! From atop Mt. of Olives we follow Palm Sunday Road to the Chapel of Dominus Flevit, traditional site where Jesus wept over Jerusalem (Luke 19:41-44) and the Garden of Gethsemane (Mark 14:36). It was here that Jesus experienced his deepest anguish, deciding to entrust himself, in total abandonment, to the will of the Father (Mark 14:36). We arrive at our hotel, our home for the next 4 nights.

## DAY 6 FRIDAY FEBRUARY 23

Today we celebrate Christmas! We pray at the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem, see the Manger and the 14-pointed star that mark the exact place of Birth of our Lord. At the Shepherd's field we remember the humble shepherds listening to the angels that sang: "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace among those whom he favors! (Luke 2:14). Back in Jerusalem there will be some free time to explore on your own before dinner.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

#### Day 7 Saturday February 24 LAST SUPPER AND PASSION OF CHRIST

We visit the Upper Room, where Jesus shared the last meal with his Apostles the night before he died. At the Church of St Peter in Gallicantu, built on top of the remains of the house of the High Priest we recall Peter's denial of Christ (Matthew 26:69-75). Enter the Old City and visit the Church of St. Ann, traditional site of the birthplace of the Virgin Mary. See the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus performed the miracle of healing (John 5:2-9). We prayerfully follow the last footsteps of Jesus as we walk the Via Dolorosa, following the Way of the Cross, something unforgettable in our pilgrimage, ending at the site of the crucifiction of Christ (Calvary), and the site of the Sepulchre.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

## DAY 8 SUNDAY FEBRUARY 25 AROUND JERUSALEM AND THE JUDEAN DESERT

This morning we visit the Church of St. Stephen, and we join in prayers to his memory at this very same spot of his martyrdom. Next we see the outdoor model of Jerusalem at the time of Jesus and visit the Western Wall and walk on the Southern Stairs --- that were the main entrance to the Temple Mount during the time of Jesus. We spend the afternoon in the Judean wilderness and at the Dead Sea we'll be able to relax and float in the salt water. This is going to be fun!

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

#### FLIGHT TEL AVIV-TORONTO DAY 9 MONDAY FEBRUARY 26

Our last day in Jerusalem. We celebrate Jesus' resurrection, He is not here, He has Risen (Matthew 28:6) and sadly we say goodbye to this Holy city. We depart to the airport for our return flight feeling deeply moved for the spiritual experience that we have just lived, knowing that we have walked in the footsteps of Jesus, the Virgin Mary and the Apostles bringing new meaning to our Scripture reading and celebration of Mass. We will cherish the memories that will last a lifetime. We land in Toronto.
