ITINERARY

DAY 1, SATURDAY-SEPTEMBER 21

FLIGHT TO SARAJEVO

We fly to Sarajevo via Zurich aboard Swiss Air. Relax and enjoy your flight with complimentary meals and in-flight movies on board. Group seating for our flight will be pre-assigned by the airline.

DAY 2, SUNDAY-SEPTEMBER 22

SARAJEVO-MEDJUGORJE

After landing in Sarajevo airport and clearing customs and immigration, we meet our guide and enjoy a panoramic drive of the city on the way to Medjugorje.

Since 1981, in this small village of Medjugorje in Bosnia-Herzegovina, the Blessed Virgin Mary has been appearing and giving messages to the world. These years that She is spending with us are a time of special Grace granted by God. In Her own words She tells us, "I have come to tell the world that God exists. He is the fullness of life, and to enjoy this fullness and peace, you must return to God".

The drive is about 2.5 hours and when we arrive, we will check-in at our hotel and enjoy free time to rest after the long journey.

DAY 3 TO 5, MONDAY TO WEDNESDAY-SEPTEMBER 23 TO 25 MEDJUGORJE

During our stay, you will experience the beauty and peace of this simple village and have the opportunity to share your faith with pilgrims from all over the world. Here are some of the activities planned for our visit:

<u>Daily Mass</u>: Each morning, at 10:00 am (noon on Sunday), the group will assemble at St. James Church for Mass and the blessing of religious articles immediately following.

Climb Apparition Hill: Recite the Rosary while climbing the hill to the place where the visionaries first encountered Our Ladv.



Climb Mt. Krizevac (Cross Mountain): In 1933, the villagers built a 30' high cross atop a mountain to commemorate Jesus' passion and death on the cross. Climb to the top, stopping 14 times along the way to rest and Pray the Stations of the Cross.

Apparitions: Join the villagers and fellow pilgrims in praying the Rosary in St. James Church at 5:00 pm (6:00 pm Daylight Savings Time) and stay for the apparition of Our Lady to the visionaries at 5:40 pm (6:40 pm Daylight Savings Time). Stay for the

Croatian Mass the Blessing of the Sick immediately following.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament: Our Lady has always called us to be close to Her Son. Join fellow pilgrims for Adoration on Tuesday and Saturday at the outside altar of St. James Church, and for Veneration of the Cross on Friday inside the church. Adoration is also available in the Chapel every afternoon.

Meetings with the Visionaries: Pending their availability, the guide will arrange meetings with the Visionaries.

Visit to the Community of Cenacolo: Founded by the Sisters of Charity, Cenacolo is a community for young men and women who have lost their way in life and are on the road to recovery. We will hear their inspirational words about their journeys back to Jesus Christ.

<u>Prayer at the Statue of the Risen Christ</u>: Pray at the bronze statue located on the grounds of St. James Church and witness the droplets of water that miraculously seep out of Christ's right knee.

DAY 6, THURSDAY-SEPTEMBER 26 MEDJUGORJE-DUBROVNIK (CROATIA)

We depart from Medjugorje towards Dubrovnik, the pearl of the Adriatic Sea. Upon arrival we take a walking tour of Old Dubrovnik. Stroll past the Baroque St. Blaise Church to Renaissance Sponza Palace and Gothic Rector's Palace. Paved with limestone, the pedestrianized Stradun (or Placa) is lined with shops and restaurants. Next, see the Dominican Monastery and the Franciscan Monastery with its Pharmacy, one of the oldest in the world.

DAY 7, FRIDAY-SEPTEMBER 27 **DUBROVNIK-PERAST (MONTENEGRO)**

Morning at leisure to explore and stroll around Dubrovnik on your own. In the afternoon we drive towards Perast, a tiny idyllic village in the Bay of Kotor, Montenegro. Perast's rich history, ancient architecture, jawdropping views, and romantic waterfront restaurant patios make it a captivating destination. Check-in at our hotel and enjoy free time to explore on your own. Breakfast, Dinner

DAY 8, SATURDAY-SEPTEMBER 28

OUR LADY OF THE ROCKS-KRAKOW (POLAND)



Take a boat ride along the scenic coast of the Bay of Kotor towards the legendary island Our Lady of the Rocks. This is a man-made islet, built upon a crag that bore the icon of the Holy Mother Mary, and it houses a church that's been built by seafarers and other locals to honor the graceful Mother Mary. It is a place where visitors can listen to the mystical story about the

island's genesis, as well as examine the many paintings, votives, and other art pieces inside the museum attached to it. We return to the mainland and drive to Dubrovnik Airport to board the flight to Krakow, former capital of Poland. Cited as one of Europe's most beautiful cities, its Old Town was declared the first UNESCO World Heritage Site in the world. Upon arrival, meet and greet by our local guide and transfer to our hotel. We get settled in our rooms and enjoy a light dinner before retiring for the evening.

DAY 9, SUNDAY-SEPTEMBER 29

KRAKOW-DIVINE MERCY

Today, Old Krakow will come alive during our sightseeing. We visit the same Franciscan Church that before becoming Pope, Carol Wojtyła frequently prayed. On Wawel Hill, we find the Royal Castle and Krakow Cathedral where we see the Shrine of Saint Stanislaus and the Cathedral Treasury and Museum. Next visit to the 14th-century Gothic St. Mary's Basilica, located in Market Square to see the world-famous Altar of the Virgin Mary, the largest of its kind in Europe. We break for lunch around the square and in the afternoon we visit the Monastery in Lagiewniki that features the Shrine of Divine Mercy proclaimed 'The center of Divine Mercy' by Pope John Paul II, 'Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy'.

DAY 10, MONDAY-SEPTEMEBER 30

OUR LADY OF CZESTOCHOWA

Day tour to Our Lady of Czestochowa where we visit the monastery at Jasna Gora, one of the most famous Marian Shrines in Europe. It is here that the miraculous icon of Our Lady with the Child Jesus, also known as the Black Madonna, is located. Also venerated as the "Queen of Poland", it has become the country's national symbol. A visit to the library and the treasury, where many valuables were hidden during the war, is also included. Breakfast, Dinner

DAY 11, TUESDAY-OCTOBER 1

WADOWICE-KRAKOW

Our last day of Pilgrimage. We visit Wadowice where John Paul II was born in 1920 and pray at the Pope's parish, visit his home and the church where he was baptized. We return to Krakow and enjoy the afternoon at leisure to stroll and explore on our own and last-minute souvenir shopping. Tonight, we toast to new friendships and enjoy a Farewell Dinner. Breakfast, Dinner

DAY 12, WEDNESDAY-OCTOBER 2

We transfer to the airport for our return flight to Toronto via Munich.
