As the school year 2025-2026 begins, students in Grade 2 or older are invited to prepare for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. First Communion requires attendance in the First Reconciliation program. Students are not admitted to the First Communion program without First Reconciliation. The preparation program will commence in person on Saturday, January 10th, 2026, from 2:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Precious Blood Parish Hall.

To register for this preparation program, you will be required to attend the **Registration & Parent Information Meeting to be held on Tuesday, November 18, 2025, at 6:30 p.m. in the Parish Hall.**

Please bring the following:

- 1) the filled-out registration form,
- 2) copy of your child's Baptismal Certificate (translated into English as required), and
- 3) \$75.00 per student enrolment fee to cover the cost of the textbooks. Only cheques or exact amount of cash are accepted.
