DID YOU KNOW?...



Our Jewish brothers and sisters are celebrating **Sukkot**, this year beginning at sundown on **Monday**, **October 6**, and concluding at sundown on **Monday**, **October 13**.

Also known as the **Festival of Tabernacles**, Sukkot is one of Judaism's three major pilgrimage festivals, along with **Passover** and **Shavuot**.

The most distinctive mitzvah (commandment) of Sukkot is dwelling in a **sukkah**—a temporary structure where many Jews eat their meals throughout the holiday. Some even sleep in the sukkah or spend as much time there as possible. The sukkah symbolizes the fragile shelters the Israelites lived in during their 40 years of wandering in the desert after leaving Egypt.

A central mitzvah of the holiday is the waving of the **Four Species**, mentioned in *Leviticus 23:40*: the **Iulav** (palm branch), **etrog** (citron), **hadasim** (myrtle branches), and **aravot** (willow branches). These are held together and waved each day of Sukkot, symbolizing unity, blessing, and gratitude to God for the bounty of the earth.
