

The **children and youth** of the parish are invited to join us for **Totus Tuus** (Latin for Totally Yours) this summer from **August 9 to August 14.**



NOVENA TO ST. JOSEPH, MARCH 10-18, 2026

Feast Day – Thursday, March 19, 2026

Always held on March 19th, the feast honors Joseph, husband to the Virgin Mary and earthly father to Jesus.



Symbols associated with Joseph include the **carpenter's square and lily**. The **carpenter's square** not only symbolizes Joseph's trade but also the concept of truth. The **lilies** symbolize integrity and indicate that Saint Joseph was the earthly spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary, whose purity is represented by the chaste white lily. **Three flowers are used to represent the Blessed Trinity.**

Join us in praying to **St. Joseph** who is the Patron Saint of home, family and protector of the Church.

Novena will be recited every morning on weekdays after the rosary and Sunday before all masses.




